Just a quick note to let you know that the "Everything I Would Want to Know if I Were Contributing to the Lehman Immanuel Approach Ministry Fund" document now includes two additional points:

IX. We will let you know when we have met our goal for each year: As described above, our goal is for the Lehman IA Ministry fund to reimburse me for just 20-25% of the time I give to the global IA community. We will keep you posted regarding the status of the training fund as each year progresses, we will let you know when we reach our goal for each year, and if funds come in beyond the goal for a given year they will roll into the funds required for the following year. You will never need to wonder, "Do they still need my contributions? And what happens to the funds if giving exceeds the goal/budget?"

X. We will let you know if we no longer need the Lehman Ministry Fund: Our hope is that income from paid consultations and product sales might some day provide sufficient income that we will no longer need support from the Lehman IA Ministry fund. We will let you know if/when this happens. You will never need to wonder, "If thousands of people start actually buying their training materials, will they just keep asking for money and start taking fancy vacations (while I'm giving sacrificially to their training fund)?"

Also, I want to pass along a clarification from Peter Horton regarding InterVarsity and IA volunteers: "The InterVarsity legal team advised to not bring in any volunteers to the conference -- it was not just IA team volunteers." My note made it sound like the Urbana leadership team was specifically discriminating against the IA Team, but that's not true.
