

Title: Fun Christmas Ideas

Greetings all,

Just a quick note to share a couple of fun Christmas ideas:

1. Get a copy of the big lion book for your friend or family member, and then put bookmarks at all of the places where the reader will find detailed Immanuel stories. For example, each of the following chapters presents an Immanuel story:

- Chap 1: Eileen, Absence Wounds, and Ice Cream
- Chap 5: Zevian, Monsters in the Closet, and BIG JESUS
- Chap 7: Healing, Freedom, and Joy for a Crack Addict
- Chap 9: Emme, Fear of Being Kidnapped, and Immanuel
- Chap 11: Bruce, Tough Questions, and Immanuel
- Chap 15: Chris, Birth Ordeal, and Immanuel
- Chap 19: Tom, Mom, and Immanuel
- Chap 23: Ian, Insecurity, and Immanuel
- Chap 27: India, Human Trafficking, and Immanuel
- Chap 30: Rita, Attachment Trauma, and Immanuel
- Chap 34: Prunes, Plums, and Immanuel
- Chap 38: Rich, CPR, and the Immanuel Fireman

And if this isn't enough, there are eight short Immanuel stories at the end of Chapter 2, and maybe fifty more Immanuel stories scattered throughout the rest of the book as examples of teaching points.

2. Get a copy of either of the new intro books for your friend or family member, and do the same thing with the stories in chapter 8. (Chapter 8 presents a collection of more than twenty-five Immanuel stories, many of which are not included in any of our other written materials).

3. Write out one or more of your own experiences with Immanuel Prayer.

Christmas is the first and biggest Immanuel story, and the whole point of Christmas is Immanuel (God with us). For each day of the entire Christmas season, the recipient of this gift could read a story of someone who has experienced the gentle, wise, wonderful, powerful, living, healing, interactive, friendship presence of Immanuel. Kind of an alternative advent calendar.
